Radisson Community Updates

The Oberon Center project, redesigning the entrance to the facility is proceeding on schedule. The majority of the demolition work has been completed and the construction of the new stairway entrance will begin soon.

The Association is continuing with its ongoing project to survey all of its Common Property in the community. The Common Property parcels being surveyed in the next few months are

located between Esprit Glade, Van Wie Drive West, Van Wie Drive East and Partridgeberry Drive. The company doing the surveying, Applied Earth Technologies, will be driving a white, company-lettered van when on-site for this project.

The maintenance staff recently cut back the row of burning bushes that line the border of Kerri Hornaday Memorial Park on Deep Glade Drive. We first noticed problems with the bushes after we experienced drastic temperature ranges in the winter of 2015 – 2016. We contacted the Master Gardeners at the Cornell Co-operative Extension who advised cutting the bushes back to the new growth that occurred last summer. We are hopeful that the roots are still healthy and will begin sprouting again in the spring.

Christmas Tree Pickup

The final week of Christmas tree pickup will be next week. Maintenance staff will be out on Monday, Wednesday and Friday to pick-up any remaining trees . Please remove all decorations and tree stands.

Mailbox Repairs

Mailbox repair and replacement service is provided by RCA Maintenance year-round. During winter months, it's not uncommon for plows to cause damage

to mailboxes and/or posts. Contact the RCA Office to request a repair. If you know who caused the damage, whether private operator or Town, you should also contact them to request reimbursement for charges.

Holiday Decoration Reminder

Holiday decorations must be removed 30 days after the holiday. If that is not possible due to weather conditions, lights can remain in place until April 1st, provided that they are not in use.

Trash & Recycling Tote Storage

As per the Architectural Standards Guidelines, trash and recycling totes may not be stored outside. Totes may be placed outside the evening before your scheduled pick-up day and must be moved indoors the same day that your trash is picked up.

Please remember to position totes with at least enough space between them (3 -4') for the automated lift arm of the truck to maneuver properly.
